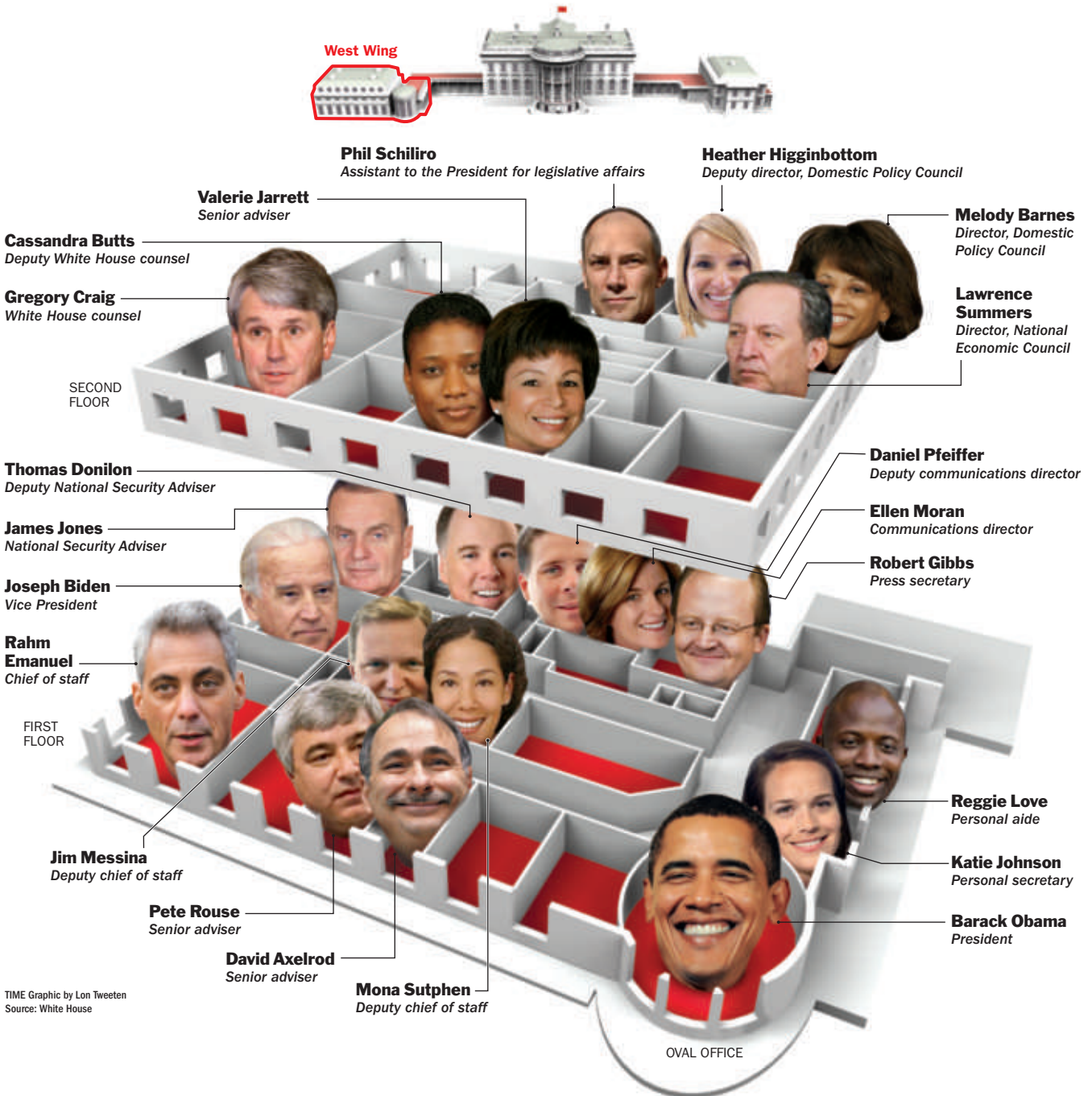

Obama's First Week

\$3,350: Cost of the enhanced-security PDA that may replace Barack Obama's beloved BlackBerry. **8:** Minimum number of hours White House staffers went without e-mail on Jan. 26, thanks to a technical glitch. **\$34,023:** Amount of self-employment taxes Treasury Secretary Timothy Geithner failed to pay on time from 2001 to 2004. The Senate confirmed him anyway, 60 to 34. **3,300:** Approximate number of presidentially appointed jobs Obama will have had to fill, from Defense Secretary to NASA administrator. **\$61,000:** Reported cost of George W. Bush's blue and gold Oval Office rug, which Obama has decided to keep, at least for now. **3:** Number of Washington restaurants Obama has visited since arriving in town—reportedly three more than Bush had visited since January of last year. —BY RANDY JAMES AND KATIE ROONEY
